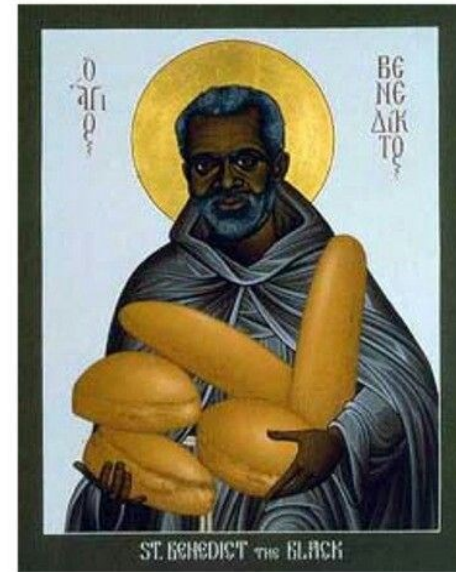

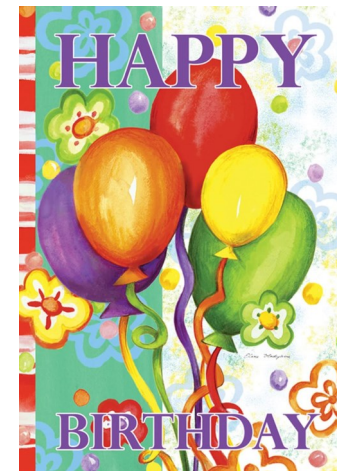

April is Sex Abuse Awareness Month.

Wear **blue** to Mass next weekend
in support of efforts to combat sexual abuse.

Every 68 seconds, an American is sexually assaulted. Every 9 minutes, the victim is a child. RAINN (Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network) reports that an average of 433,600 Americans [age 12 and older] are sexually assaulted or raped each year, and 60,000 children are victims of substantiated or indicated sexual abuse. RAINN also reports that sexual assault overwhelmingly impacts women with 90% of victims being female.

Some helpful responses when someone confides in you:

"I believe you."

"It's not your fault." Sexual assault is never the victim's fault.

"You are not alone."

"I'm sorry this happened. / This shouldn't have happened to you."
