USCCB Action Alert - Climate Change Legislation

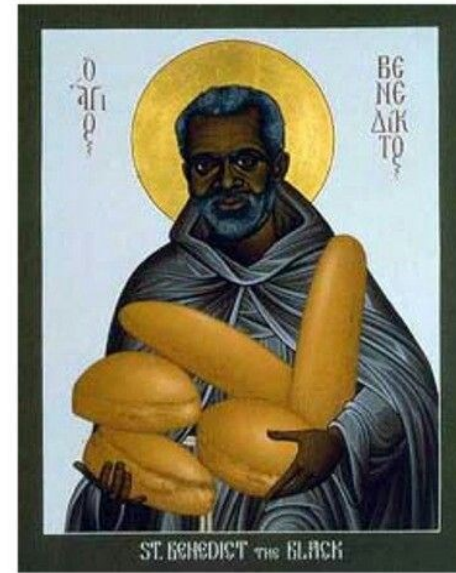
